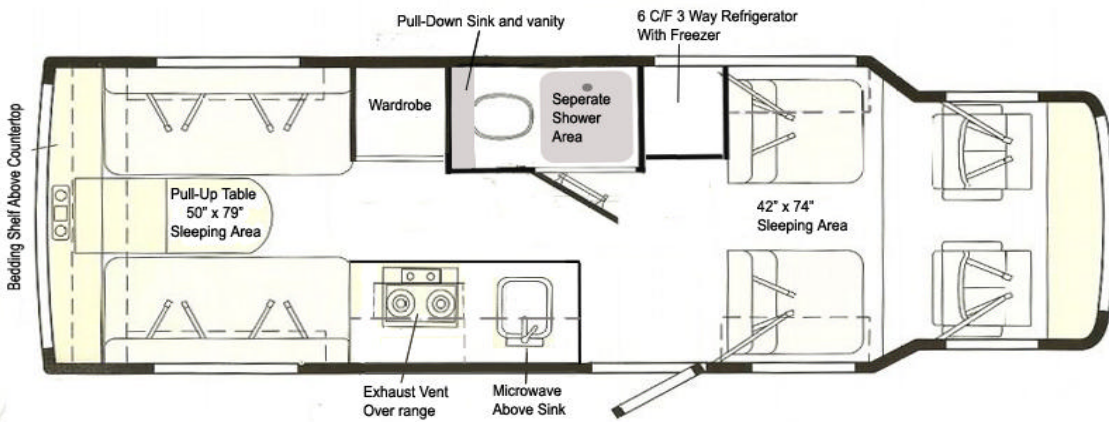


The Rialta Winnebago should have built.....



26 feet with air ride suspension on rear (requires no axles so you have 6 foot head room in galley area). This would also allow for larger holding tanks for both Grey Water and Black Water. It could have had a separate shower area (no need for the expanding bathroom) and a full size galley with a stove and vent hood over the range. Plenty of room for a 6 cubic foot refrigerator with a separate freezer. With all this extra room there would be storage everywhere with the largest areas under the sink and above or below the refrigerator.



There you have it the Ultimate Rialta...just add a turbo charged VR6 or better yet a Chrysler Mini Van front end and I bet Winnebago could not build them fast enough.
