New entertainment system and interior upgrades

I updated the entertainment system to a Concertone ZX550 all in one system. The system includes a DVD/CD/Mp3/TV tuner with AM/FM/Weather radio and includes aux inputs for Satellite TV and my IPAD. The system has 200 watts of audio output and supports output to 3 video screens with select audio output to 3 rooms. The system includes a remote control and push button head unit.



The head unit is mounted into the transition panel behind the driver seat. I had to make a custom trim piece because the area behind the panel was not deep enough for the head unit and all the wiring. There are a zillion wires and connections on the back including power and antenna along with all the speakers and video.





The video outputs to 2 screens. The main screen is a drop down 22 inch monitor mounted in the cab ceiling. This screen can also display output from a laptop or the IPod. The second screen in a 7 inch drop down mounted under the rear cabinet. You can watch the same video that is playing on the main screen or the satellite on this screen. This allows you to watch TV or DVD on the main screen and Satellite TV on the rear screen at the same time. This monitor will also swivel so it can be viewed from the kitchen area and is great for watching TV in the rear bed or at the table. The system outputs audio from 4 speakers and 2 subwoofers. The speakers are mounted in the front and rear of the living area and the subwoofers are mounted under the front seats.





The silver display panel located beside the elevation readout (small white panel) is an Acu-Rite weather station. This station has indoors and out door temperature, humidity, wind chill, wind speed and direction. It is a wireless system that connects to a sensor array that is mounted on a pole that can be placed on top of the rear of the motor home. The pole is mounted using a flag pole holder and can be installed by standing on the rear cargo carrier frame. The Direct TV satellite receiver is located in the front overhead cabinet and is powered by a 12v/110vinverter. This allows us to watch Direct TV when we are not connected to shore power. The Concertone system and the video monitors are 12v so they work as long as the batteries hold out. The dish is mounted in the location of the old Batwing antenna and uses the same holes for the controls. The dish is also equipped with an elevation readout that assists in aiming the antenna. The elevation display panel is mounted on the end of the microwave cabinet.







The Cockpit with Satellite Radio, Blue Tooth Radio, 7 inch GPS/Backup camera, Drink holders and ProClip cell phone mount.
